City of Pocatello is looking at the realignment of Gathe Rd. again. Calvary Chapel is downsizing and looked at the St. Paul's property. They are very interesting and asked about the possibility of leasing the property. Capital Campaign Pledge update was handed out. A few of the summer projects that Fr. John will be doing is contacting new parishioners to get them on board and sending out 49 letters to families who have pledged but have not started paying yet. He would like to get the Building Core Committee back together to revamp the design and be able to get the architects to come here in late summer or early fall. We need to maintain and take care of what we have while looking into the future.
